

## **Stewardship Team Meeting March 20, 2011**

1. Meeting opened with prayer by Don Chapman.

2. Sheila Neal gave us a letter of resignation as Secretary at Mulford Church effective Friday, June 24, 2011. She has been Secretary for 15 years & six months. Pastor Jerry attended the meeting to give us some input for hiring a replacement for Sheila. Sheila would like a month to train the new Secretary. After discussion, it was agreed to place an ad in the bulletin and newspaper. These ads will run for two weeks with applications and resumes due by May 1. Applications can be picked up from Sheila in Secretary's office. Stewardship Team members along with Pastor Jerry will review the resumes and get it down to 3-5 top ones. After that the top ones will be interviewed individually. Pastor Jerry was then dismissed.

3. Treasurer's Report by Don Chapman as of 3/21/11 (as of 3/13/11 was given at meeting). Week 12 we are \$11,468.57 under budget on income (\$955.71 per week). Our expenses are \$8,243.66 under budget. 1st qt missions have all been paid except \$167.75 leaving our General Fund balance at \$8,643.96. Our Special Accounts balance is at \$26,140.77. Check book balance is at \$34,784.73.

Budget should be at 23% with Team Budgets as follows: E.T. 21%, F.T. 47%, O.T. 22%, S.T. 21%, W.T. 8% & D.T. 11%. Total Team budgets is at 20%.

4. Church sign working again by Lange Sign Group.

5. 2011 goals completed - Boiler room cleaned out and organized, Youth Lounge closet cleaned out and South attic cleaned out and shelving installed. Check them out. Still have three areas to work on yet.

6. Painting of Youth Lounge was done Saturday 3/19/11. Thank you Jim Painter for heading this up with the help of Mary Jane Painter and Donna and Tom Vandygriff.

7. Guttering on air conditioner room has been rerouted to the grassy court yard area. This takes away some of the water forming on the parking lot in this area.

8. Church use request by Matt & Tammy Allison for Sunday May 22, from 12:00 to 5:00 for Paige's graduation.

9. Fred Levinson has requested use of our field for soccer practices starting Monday, March 28. Practices to be held on Mondays and Thursdays from 5:15 to 6:30. Additional practices will also be held on Saturday 3/19 from 1:00 to 2:15, Tuesday 3/22 from 5:15 to 6:30 and Thursday 3/24 from 5:15 to 6:30.

10. Rosa de Saron services started on Sat. 3/19. They will just hold two services for now on Saturdays 5:00 till 8:00 and on Sundays 3:00 to 6:00. Trustees have been assigned dates to unlock and lock the church for their services for next two months. Starting the third month they will be issued their own key or keys. Everything went well this first weekend. Rosa de Saron in English stands for Rose of Sharon.

11. Gray van will be taken to Krieger's for some repair work.

12. Some interest has been expressed for a Sunday morning Van ministry for Sunday school and Church. Trustees initially gave approval for use of van for this ministry. Interested parties will be notified of our approval.
